Substance use disorder in America

Substance use disorders are historically underreported due to stigma and potential implications. According to Mental Health America*, a nonprofit community organization helping those with behavioral health needs:

- 7.74% of adults in America reported having a substance use disorder in the past year.
- 2.97% of adults in America reported having an illicit drug use disorder in the past year.
- 5.71% of adults in America reported having an alcohol use disorder in the past year.
- 4.08% of youth in the U.S. reported having a substance use disorder in the past year.
- 1.64% of youth in the U.S. had an alcohol use disorder in the past year, while 3.16% had an illicit drug use disorder.
