WALK-IN CLINICS

You have a minor illness or injury and your primary care provider isn't available — drop in to a retail health clinic or urgent care center. They offer convenient, in-person care without an appointment right around the corner from your home, work or school.

Why go to a retail health clinic?

- Evening and weekend hours
- Often located in pharmacies so you can get your prescriptions filled
- Care provided by physician assistants and certified nurse practitioners, overseen by a U.S. board-certified doctor

Why go to an urgent care center?

- Evening and weekend hours
- May offer labs and X-rays
- Care provided by U.S. board-certified doctors, nurses and nurse practitioners
