Board-Certified Behavior Analysts

If you meet the requirements for receiving applied behavior analysis, you must obtain that treatment from a board-certified behavior analyst. The analyst must obtain approval from Blue Cross/BCN before providing those services in order for your treatment to be covered.


Note: For Blue Care Network, the board-certified behavior analyst must be a provider for your health plan in order for you to obtain coverage for applied behavior analysis.

Blue Cross and BCN continue to build their network of board-certified behavior analysts.

The names of BCBA's are now available solely in the provider search at **bcbsm.com**. To access those names, do the following:

1. Visit **bcbsm.com**.
2. Click **Find a Doctor**.
3. Click *Get started*.
4. In the "Choose a health plan" field, select your health plan.
5. In the "Search for people or places" field, type "behavioral analyst."
6. In the "Choose a location" field, type a city, ZIP code, county or full address.
7. Click *Search*. The names that appear are the behavior analysts who accept the plan you have.
8. In the search results, click the name of a behavior analyst and review the information about him or her.

Note: In the "Board Certifications" field, you'll see "No data available." That just means that the search does not display board certification data for nonphysician practitioners such as behavior analysts.
