



Generic Copay Waiver Program – Multiple Source Brand Drugs

For members using the brand-name drugs in the Target Brand column, BCBSM will send a letter encouraging members to discuss with their physician or pharmacist the opportunity to switch to the generic drugs indicated in the Preferred Generic column. If the member's physician or pharmacist considers the switch appropriate and a preferred generic is filled, BCBSM will waive the first copay for the preferred generic.
