



Vaccine Coverage Guide for Medicare PPO Members

Understanding your health plan coverage just got easier.

Be informed.

Staying up to date on your immunizations can reduce your risk of contracting serious illnesses.

Your retirement system health plan covers many vaccines to keep you healthy. As a Medicare health plan, your plan must cover all services covered by Original Medicare and must follow Original Medicare's coverage rules. Therefore, some of the vaccines are covered by your medical plan, administered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan. Other vaccines are covered by your prescription drug plan, administered by Optum Rx.

You pay \$0 for vaccines covered by your retirement system health plan.

WHERE CAN I GET VACCINATED?

You can get the vaccines in the chart above at the following locations:

- Retail health clinic or Health Department.
- Doctor's office.

HOW TO GET REIMBURSED.

Occasionally, members may have to pay out of pocket first for covered vaccines. If you receive a covered vaccine at a location that is unable to bill Blue Cross, you'll have to pay the out-of-pocket cost and submit a request to Blue Cross for reimbursement.

For medical plan reimbursement requests, you will need to complete the online reimbursement claim form from your online Blue Cross member account at **bcbsm.com/mpsers** or on the Blue Cross mobile app.

Keep in mind that the medical and prescription drug plans are administered separately. This means Blue Cross and Optum Rx can only answer questions about the coverage they provide and cannot answer questions about the other plans.

You'll need to review both charts in this guide to help you understand your retirement system vaccine coverage. The charts are organized by carrier, so you will see vaccines covered by your Blue Cross medical plan on Page 1. On Page 2, you'll see vaccines covered by your Optum Rx prescription drug plan.

WHERE CAN I GET VACCINATED?

You can get the vaccines in the chart on Page 2 at the following locations:

- In-network pharmacy. To locate an in-network pharmacy, log in to your online member account at **optumrx.com** or call the number on your prescription ID card.
- Retail health clinic or Health Department.
- Doctor's office. Your doctor can administer the vaccine or you can ask them to send an electronic prescription to your local, in-network pharmacy.

HOW TO GET REIMBURSED.

If you receive a covered vaccine at your doctor's office, retail health clinic or Health Department, you'll have to pay the out-of-pocket cost and submit a request for reimbursement for it to be covered.

For prescription drug plan reimbursement requests, you will need to complete the online reimbursement claim form at dmrforms.optumrx.com/online-claim-form. Costs for a visit to the doctor's office are not reimbursable.
