<p>My Medicare Advantage plan covers select drugs through Medicare Part B.</p> <p>What types of drugs are available? How can I get them?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All Blue Cross Medicare Advantage BCN Advantage HMO members can get select Part B drugs, including nebulizer solutions and oral cancer medications, at their local pharmacy beginning on May 27. ▪ The following are types of drugs covered by Part B: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Drugs used with an item or durable medical equipment – Some antigens – Injectable osteoporosis drugs – Erythropoiesis-stimulating agents – Blood-clotting factors – Injectable and infused drugs – Oral end stage renal disease drugs – Parenteral and enteral nutrition for intravenous and tube feeding – Intravenous immune globulin, or IVIG, provided in home – Vaccinations – Transplant and immunosuppressive drugs ▪ Members should show their BCNA membership ID card at their local pharmacy to use this benefit. This benefit can also be used through their designated mail order pharmacy.
<p>Where can I view the drug list?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ There's a link on the microsite that provides basic information about Medicare Part B. Members who visit bcbsm.com/UAWTrust will be able to view the list of available drugs being offered through their plan.
<p>What's my out-of-pocket cost for Medicare Part B drugs?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Coverage at 100% in or out of network on all Medicare Part B prescriptions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – For certain oral anti-cancer and anti-nausea drugs, and certain immunosuppressive drugs following a Medicare covered transplant, services are a benefit under your plan up to 100% of approved amount.

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
