Blue Cross Community Responsibility makes corporate contributions to Michigan-based, nonprofit partner organizations seeking to improve the health and wellness of people in our state's many diverse communities. 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Detroit Neighborhood Initiative

In 2018, Blue Cross and six other organizations joined the City of Detroit to help revitalize specific areas of the city. As part of the **Detroit Neighborhood Initiative**, Blue Cross contributed **\$5 million** over the last five years to Detroit's Strategic Neighborhood Fund and has worked to help bring inclusive community development to our partnership neighborhood located between East Warren and Cadieux Streets.

Since that time, Blue Cross' Community Responsibility team has collaborated with many organizations in the East English Village, Cornerstone and Morningside neighborhoods to build relationships, bring needed resources and help reestablish a healthy, thriving community. 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
