

CMS INTEROPERABILITY RULE Documentation for Third-party App Developers

The Interoperability and Patient Access final rule requires CMS-regulated payers to implement and maintain a secure, standards-based Patient Access Application Programming Interface (API) that enables patients to access their health information through a third-party application of their choice.

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan is required to comply with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Interoperability and Patient Access Final Rule and is using the InterOp Station® to support these API connections with third-party applications.

In order to enable API connections, third-party developers must register their app with InterOp Station to make the app available for use by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and Blue Care Network members.
