

Finding providers to provide injectable medications to treat opioid use and behavioral health conditions through home infusion therapy and ambulatory infusion centers

For Blue Cross PPO (commercial) members

If your doctor has prescribed an injectable medication for opioid use or some behavioral health conditions, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan PPO members may be able to have the injection administered in your home or an ambulatory infusion center (AIC). Contact your doctor for a referral or call the behavioral health number on the back of your Blue Cross ID card for assistance.

J2794	Injection, risperidone, long acting, 0.5 mg
J2315	Injection, naltrexone, depot form, 1 mg
Q9991	Injection, buprenorphine extended-release (sublocade), less than or equal to 100 mg
Q9992	Injection, buprenorphine extended-release (sublocade), greater than 100 mg
