The diabetes supplies covered at pharmacies include glucometers, continuous glucose monitors, test strips, lancets and certain insulin delivery devices. Certain glucometers and continuous glucose monitor components are available through pharmacy benefits with no copayment. Other supplies will be covered according to your plan's drug list and the corresponding pharmacy copay.
