Adult intensive services and child intensive services

Child and adult intensive services address the needs of at-risk members by:

- Eliminating barriers and gaps in care
- Closely coordinating among treating providers, caregivers and community resources
- Maintaining court orders (if indicated)
- Providing support for caregivers so they continue to be able to address members' needs and maintain housing and activities of daily living services

Services include assessment and treatment planning, case management, peer support, in-home respite and other services. These services are primarily for members with two or more chronic illnesses, such as major depression, bipolar illness or a psychotic disorder that may have continued suicidal ideation without a plan, severe depression symptoms, psychosis or severe childhood issues.

These services are commonly known as wrap-around services or whole-person care and are delivered by community provider partners.
