## Eating and feeding disorder treatment centers

Members with feeding disorders — such as anorexia nervosa, binge eating disorder, bulimia nervosa, avoidant restrictive food intake disorder and other specific feeding disorders — may benefit from higher levels of care that specialize in the treatment of these disorders.

Treatment for members with feeding disorders may include a combination of an intensive outpatient program, partial hospitalization or residential care in a specialized psychiatric residential treatment facility.

## Important:

- Check each member's eligibility and benefits to determine whether eating and feeding disorder treatment is a covered service. To do this, call the behavioral health number on the back of the member's Blue Cross or BCN member ID card.
- Providers must request prior authorization for some services, which requires submitting clinical documentation to meet medical necessity criteria.
