Mobile crisis services

Mobile crisis services provide emergency mobile mental health assessments and interventions for adults and children who are in immediate crisis.

Mobile units consist of a behavioral health clinician and a peer support specialist. They can be deployed to a patient's home, office or emergency department to assess the patient's need, reduce symptoms, begin support and transition the patient to the least-restrictive level of care.

The initial services include a face-to-face intervention and an assessment. An individualized treatment plan is completed within 96 hours of service. Once assessed, patients are connected to the correct level of aftercare treatment.
