

Blueprint allocation amount of 1.5% to go into effect July 1, 2023

We'll be introducing a 1.5% allocation from Blue Cross commercial (PPO) professional fees to fund Blueprint risk arrangements for our Blue Cross commercial providers, starting July 1, 2023. Reminder: Double-check Blue Cross commercial members' coverage for COVID-19 vaccines

Some Blue Cross commercial members have group plans that are exempt from complying with Affordable Care Act requirements. During the public health emergency, we've been covering 100% of the costs for administering COVID-19 vaccines to these members.

Effective April 1, 2023, these members will revert to their pre-pandemic vaccine coverage, unless their group requested otherwise. As a result, they may have out-of-pocket costs or may not have vaccine coverage. Read more: April 2023 issue of The Record
