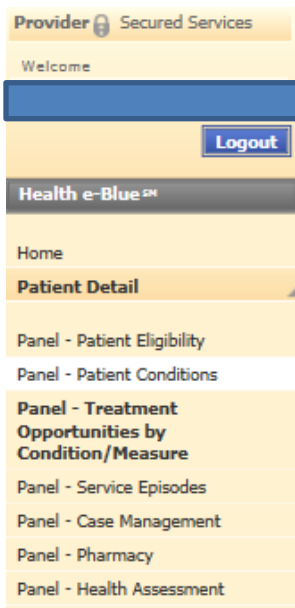




# Pharmacy Opportunities Focus: Health e-Blue<sup>SM</sup> pharmacy 2020

## Obtaining pharmacy claims data from Health e-Blue

1. Access **BCN's Health e-Blue pharmacy portal**.
2. On the left-hand column, locate the tab **Panel-Pharmacy**.



3. The **Panel-Pharmacy** allows you to search by PCP, date range, drug name and Therapeutic Class.

# Pharmacy Opportunities Focus: Health e-Blue<sup>SM</sup> pharmacy 2020

- Referencing the **Pharmacy Opportunities Focus: Spring 2020**, search records by Therapeutic Class. The Spring 2020 Focus highlights various Therapeutic Classes that include high-cost drugs where lower-cost alternatives may exist.#
- For each Therapeutic Class, an Excel file (“CSV” below) can be generated. Make sure that “match” is selected for Prescriber and PCP to identify prescriptions prescribed by the PCP.

- Alternatively, an Excel file can be generated for all pharmacy claims and filtered by fields of interest as needed. Make sure to select the PO name from the dropdown list and desired year of service.
- The pharmacy claims data can be used to identify patients on high-cost drugs where lower-cost alternatives may exist. We recommend focusing on the following fields in the Excel file, which contain the necessary information to notify prescribers of opportunities:

Field name	Definition
MBR_LAST_NM	Member last name
MBR_FIRST_NM	Member first name
MBR_DOB	Member date of birth
RX_PCP_PRV_LAST_NM	Primary care provider last name
RX_PCP_PRV_FIRST_NM	Primary care provider first name
PCH_DT	Purchase date
DRUG_CAT	Drug category (generic, brand, etc.)
DRUG_NM	Drug name
DRUG_STRN_QTY	Drug strength
AMNT_PD	Amount paid (plan)
MBR_AMT_PD	Member paid
TOT_AMT_PD	Total amount paid (member plus plan)
PRSB_PRV_NM	Prescribing provider name
PCP_PRSB_IND	PCP prescribing indicator (1 = prescriber same as PCP, 0 = prescriber not the same as PCP)
FRM_IND	Formulary indicator

## Obtaining the primary care physician scorecard from Health e-Blue

1. Access **BCN's Health e-Blue pharmacy** portal.

3. The **Pharmacy Profile Report** allows you to search by PCP and Report Year.
4. The search tool provides the option to 1) select the PO name from the dropdown list and then select PCPs associated with that PO or 2) search by PCP name.

5. This will generate a report specific to the PCP. The “% generic dispensed” and “% formulary compliance” are hyperlinks which will generate a separate window to identify prescriptions filled nongeneric or nonformulary, respectively. These fields may be helpful to focus on, with further investigation using the pharmacy claims data to identify more details about the associated medications or members.
