The inpatient hospital care limit does not apply to inpatient mental services provided in a general hospital.</p> <p>The copays for hospital benefits are based on benefit periods. A benefit period begins the day you're admitted as an inpatient and ends when you haven't received any inpatient care for 60 days in a row. If you go into a hospital after one benefit period has ended, a new benefit period begins. You must pay the inpatient hospital deductible for each benefit period. There's no limit to the number of benefit periods.</p> <p>Our plan covers 90 days for an inpatient hospital stay.</p> <p>Our plan also covers 60 "lifetime reserve days." Phase 1: The Deductible Stage

You pay \$250 per year for Part D prescription drugs except for drugs listed on Tier 1, Tier 2 and 6 which are excluded from the deductible.

Phase 2: The Initial Coverage Stage

After you pay your yearly deductible, you pay the following until your total yearly drug costs reach \$3,820. Total yearly drug costs are the total drug costs paid by both you and our Part D plan.
