Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan has joined the State of Michigan to offer the Healthy Kids Dental (HKD) program at no cost to you. We have a large network of dentists to help you keep your children healthy.

Your Blue Cross HKD program benefits

We have a large network of dentists to help your child stay healthy. Before a service is performed, ask your Healthy Kids Dental network dentist if it's covered by your plan. You must pay for services not covered by Blue Cross. Find more details on the covered benefits and limitations in the Healthy Kids Dental member handbook. It's available by mail and on the website.

COVERED SERVICES

- Oral exams
NOTE: Children should have a first dental visit when the first tooth comes in, or by age 1. Then, your child should have a dental exam every six months.
- Teeth cleanings
- Fluoride treatments
- X-rays
- Screenings and assessments
- Fillings
- Sealants
- Stainless steel or resin crowns
- Crown buildup, including pins
- Space maintainers
- Re-cementing crowns, bridges and space maintainers
- Root canals
- Extractions
- Complete, partial and temporary partial dentures
- Denture adjustments and repairs
- Denture rebases and relines
- Emergency treatment to reduce pain
- IV sedation (when needed)

If your child needs services not listed above due to a health or oral health condition have your dentist request prior approval.

SERVICES THAT AREN'T COVERED INCLUDE:

- Full mouth or panoramic X-rays under age 5
- Bite guards
- Removal of healthy third molars (*wisdom teeth*)
- Bridges, inlays and onlays
- Bite Splints, mouthguards, sports appliances
- Analgesia, inhalation of nitrous oxide
- Orthodontic services (*such as braces*)
NOTE: If your child has certain medical or dental conditions, orthodontic services may be covered under the Children's Special Health Care Services program. Contact your local health department regarding CSHCS eligibility.
- Implants
- Cosmetic dentistry
- Services covered under a hospital, surgical or medical or prescription drug program
- Treatment of TMJ (*TMJ is a problem that can cause pain in your jaw joint and muscles that control jaw movement.*)
