

Billing for COVID-19 vaccine administration

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and Blue Care Network are providing billing guidelines for COVID-19 vaccine administration. We first told you about our vaccine coverage in an alert published Dec. 11, 2020. Here are some important points and reminders.

The COVID-19 vaccine is paid for through funding authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security, or CARES Act. Providers may not bill for the cost of any free government-provided vaccine and related products or supplies. Providers can bill Blue Cross and BCN only for the administration of the vaccine for commercial members.

If a member visits a physician's office or urgent care center only to receive the vaccine, do not bill for an office visit.
