

FDA authorizes additional vaccine dose for certain immunocompromised individuals – vaccine documents updated

On August 12, 2021, the [U.S. Food and Drug Administration](#) amended the emergency use authorization (EUA) for both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines to allow for the use of an additional dose in certain immunocompromised individuals. These individuals include solid organ transplant recipients.

Additional billing codes have been established for these doses. Providers should use *0003A for the Pfizer vaccine and *0013A for the Moderna vaccine.
