

Telehealth codes remain billable through the end of the PHE for Medicare Advantage members

Temporary changes due to the pandemic

Eligible Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and Blue Care Network Medicare Advantage providers can bill for telehealth services through the duration of the public health emergency as part of the [COVID-19 Emergency Declaration Blanket Waivers for Health Care Providers](#). Our Medicare Advantage members pay \$0 cost share for Medicare-covered telehealth services through Dec. 31, 2020. Beginning Jan. 1, 2021, applicable cost share will apply. CMS may expand the list of covered telehealth services beyond the public health emergency. We'll follow CMS guidance for those services.

Medicare Advantage plan coverage change for 2021

Our 2021 Medicare Advantage individual plan coverage includes \$0 cost share for primary care provider and behavioral health telehealth visits furnished by eligible providers as well as our vendor, Amwell®, through Dec. 31, 2021, the end of the plan year. For group plan members, 2021 benefits communicated in their group benefit documents will apply. Please check your patient's eligibility and benefits regarding these services.

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
