

## Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and Blue Care Network reinstate waiving of early medication refill limits for commercial products

In compliance with a new Michigan law effective Dec. 29, 2020, Blue Cross and BCN have again increased access to prescription medications for Blue Cross and BCN commercial members. Waiving early medication refill limits has been reinstated and is effective until March 31, 2021.

This applies to 30- and 90-day prescription maintenance medications for chronic conditions (excluding controlled substances).

We previously announced the temporary waiving of early medication refill limits had concluded for commercial products in a July 14, 2020 provider alert. (The early waiver refill has been in place for Medicare members since March 2020 and remains in effect until further notice.)

Quantity limits on some prescription drugs for Blue Cross and BCN commercial members continue until further notice. Please consult the *Temporary quantity limits on some prescription drugs during the COVID-19 pandemic* document for more information.
